Benha University (BU) traced its roots to the first high school of Agriculture in Egypt, founded in 1911, then as a branch of Zagazig University in 1976. In 2005, BU has been separated as an independent comprehensive university. BU has 16 colleges. BU has about 5000 faculty members serving more than 100 thousand students. At present, it takes 40 minutes to get from Benha to the Egyptian capital. By every measure, BU is one of the prestigious Universities in Egypt and the Arab region.

BU has wide international collaboration with many of the prestigious institutions all over the world. BU is a member of well-known international academic bodies such as being an executive committee member of the University Alliance of Silk Road (UASR) as well as the membership of Association of Arab Universities. Because of its international reputation, BU is increasingly attracting more international students from the Arab, Asian and African countries. For this purpose, BU is establishing a new international branch Obour Campus located in Cairo to include all the international and joint-educational activities under one umbrella in this campus.to shorten the journey time.


Undoubtedly, rankings now play such a big role in shaping the opinions of current and potential students, parents, employers, and government about the quality of tertiary education institutions.

About Times Higher Education Rankings

Times Higher Education became known for publishing the annual Times Education-QS World University Rankings, which first appeared in November 2004. On 30 October 2009 Times Higher Education broke with Quacquarelli Symonds, then its partner in compiling the Rankings, and agreement with Thomson signed an Reuters to provide the data instead. The magazine developed a new methodology in consultation with its readers and its board and the results were editorial published annually from autumn 2010 to 2013, when THE signed a new deal with Elsevier.

THE Release

World University Rankings

THE (Times Higher Education) has been providing trusted performance data on universities for students and their families. university academics, university leaders, governments, and industry, since 2004. the THE World University Rankings, is the definitive list of the top universities globally, including more than 1,250 institutions across 86 countries in 2019. It is the only global league university table to iudge research-intensive universities across each one of their core missions: teaching (the learning environment); research (volume, and reputation), international income outlook (staff, students and research); citations (research influence); industry income (knowledge transfer). It uses 13 carefully calibrated performance indicators to provide the most comprehensive and balanced comparisons, and all data is independently audited by professional firm PricewaterhouseCoopers services (PwC), making the THE World University

In the 2019 release of this ranking, BU appeared for the first time to occupy the first rank at the level of Egypt in conjunction with 4 other universities for the same local arrangement and also occupied the ranking 601-800 internationally within 1400 universities from 92 countries around the world.





Impact Rankings 2020

The Times Higher Education Impact Rankings are the only global performance tables that assess universities against the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). We use carefully calibrated indicators to provide comprehensive and balanced comparisons across three broad areas: research, outreach and stewardship. This second edition includes 768 universities from 85 countries.



THE Young University Rankings 2020



The Times Higher Education Young University Rankings list the world's best universities that are 50 years old or younger.

The table of ranking is based on the same 13 performance indicators as the flagship THE World University Rankings, but the weightings have been adjusted to give less weight to reputation.

The universities are judged across all their core missions – teaching, research, knowledge transfer and international outlook – to provide the most comprehensive and balanced comparisons available.

The 2020 ranking includes 414 universities, up from 351 in 2019.

In the year 2020, BU appeared for the first time in The Times Higher Education Young University Rankings, which ranks universities worldwide 50 years old or less, to occupy the university in the third place in Egypt within the 14 universities that appeared in ranking and ranking 201-250 at the world level among more than 414 University appeared in this release

THE World University Rankings by subject



The 2020 Times Higher Education World University Rankings table for education subjects uses the same trusted and rigorous performance indicators as our overall World University Rankings, but the weightings have been recalibrated to suit the individual fields.

The ranking assesses universities by their performance in education, teacher training and academic studies in education subjects. This year's table includes 477 universities, up from 428 last year.

Benha University Ranking

BU has emerged among the top 500 universities in the world in the fields of Engineering and Technological Sciences – Life Sciences – Clinical, PreClinical &Helath also in Physics







In 2020 BU appeared in new specializations such as life sciences, clinical medical sciences and health sciences to occupy the 601+ ranking in each of them globally, and the university's ranking in the field of engineering and technological sciences improved to join the university for the best 400 universities in the world in this specialization.



THE Emerging Economies University Rankings 2020

The Times Higher Education Emerging Economies University Rankings 2020 includes only institutions in countries classified by the London Stock Exchange's FTSE Group as "advanced emerging", "secondary emerging" or "frontier".

The rankings use the same 13 performance indicators as the THE World University Rankings to judge institutions on their teaching, research, knowledge transfer and international outlook. But they are recalibrated to reflect the development priorities of universities in emerging economies.

About QS World University Rankings

It is an annual ranking for universities around the world and is published by the British company Quacquarelli Symonds, which was originally publishing its rankings through the Times Higher Education publications from 2004 to 2009 under the name "World Universities Ranking for The Times Higher Education and Quacarelli Simmonds".

QS publishes an annual report that ranks more than 30,000 universities worldwide ranked according to academic and scientific standards.

It is also making a comparison of the largest 500 universities, to issue a guide for universities, by relying on evaluation criteria that address the structural structure of each of these universities.

Arab Region University Rankings 2020.

First published in 2014, the annual QS Arab Region University Rankings highlights 130 leading universities in this part of the world. The methodology for this ranking has been developed with the aim of reflecting specific challenges and priorities for institutions in the region, drawing on the following 10 indicators. The percentages indicate the weighting given to each component when calculating the overall results

- Citations per Papers

The Ranking Web or Webometrics is the largest ranking of academic Higher Education Institutions. Since 2004 and every six months an independent, objective, free, open scientific exercise is performed by the Cybernetics Lab (Spanish National Research Council, CSIC) for the providing reliable, multidimensional. updated and useful information about the performance of universities from all over the world based on their web presence and impact.

* Ranking Web started in 2004 (current is the 17th year of publication) with the aim of offer full coverage of Higher Education Institutons whatever the country or discipline involve. Currently They ranked 30 000 HEIs from more than 200 countries The primary objective of the Ranking Web is to promote Open Access to the knowledge generated by the University.

About Academic Ranking of World Universities





The Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) was first published in June 2003 by the Center for World-Class Universities (CWCU), Graduate School of Education (formerly the Institute of Higher Education) of Shanghai Jiao Tong University, China, and updated on an annual basis. Since 2009 the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) has been published and copyrighted by Shanghai Ranking Consultancy. Shanghai Ranking Consultancy is a fully independent organization on higher education intelligence and not legally subordinated to any universities government agencies.

ARWU uses six objective indicators to rank world universities, including the number of alumni and staff winning Nobel Prizes and Fields Medals, number of highly cited researchers selected by Clarivate Analytics, number of articles published in journals of

Nature and Science, number of articles indexed in Science Citation Index - Expanded and Social Sciences Citation Index, and per capita performance of a university. More than 1800 universities are ranked by ARWU every year and the best 1000 are published.

Benha University Ranking

BU appeared for the first time in 2019 to occupy the rankings 151-200 in the world in the field of veterinary sciences. Benha University shares the rankings of some American universities such as Oregon and Harvard, and the University of Benha came second in the local level in the same specialty with the universities of Cairo and Kafr El Sheikh.

These institutions from the U.S. and more than 60 other countries have been ranked based on 13 indicators that measure their academic research performance and their global and regional reputations. Students can use these rankings to explore the higher education options that exist beyond their own countries' borders and to compare key aspects of schools' research missions. These are the world's top 1,500 universities.

The overall Best Global Universities rankings encompass the top **1,500** institutions spread across **81** countries. The first step in producing these rankings, which are powered by Clarivate Analytics Incites, involved creating a pool of **1,599** universities that was used to rank the top **1,500** schools.

About UI Green Metrics

The UI Green Metric World University Ranking is an initiative of Universities Indonesia which is being launched in 2010. As part of its strategy of raising its international standing, the University hosted an International Conference on World University Rankings on 16 April 2009. several experts on invited world It university rankings such as Isidro Aguillo (Webometrics), Angela Yung-Chi (HEEACT), and Alex Usher (Educational Policy Canada). It was clear from the discussions that current criteria being used to rank universities were not giving credit to those that were making efforts to reduce their carbon footprint and thus help combat global climate change. We were aware that several top world universities, for example Harvard, Chicago, Copenhagen have been taking steps to manage and improve their sustainability.

There are also cooperative efforts among groups of universities.

A grading system which includes information on sustainability at 300 universities exists under the title the United States Green Report Card. This is excellent; however, results are given in terms of a grade (A to F) rather than a ranking and the number of universities included is relatively circumscribed. We saw the need for a uniform system that would be suitable to attract the support of thousands of the world's universities and where the results were based on a numerical score that would allow ranking so that quick comparisons could be made among them on the criteria of their commitment to addressing the problems of sustainability and environmental impact.





Academic and research-related Institutions are ranked by a composite indicator that combines three different sets of indicator. based on research performance, innovation outputs and societal impact.

Benha University leads 3 places internationally in the research performance standard according to the Spanish Simago ranking 2020 This year, BU ranked 404th in the world among 7026 academic and research institutions worldwide in this standard, while locally ranked ninth in 41 universities and research institutions.

The Center for World University Rankings (CWUR) is a leading consulting organization providing policy advice, strategic insights, and consulting services to governments and universities to improve educational and research outcomes.

Since 2012, CWUR has been publishing the only academic ranking of global universities that assesses the quality of education, alumni employment, research output, and citations without relying on surveys and university data submissions. The ranking started out as a project in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia with the aim of rating the top 100 world universities. It was quickly reported worldwide by universities and the media and many requests were received to expand it. In 2019, the ranking expanded to list the top 2000 out of twenty thousand universities worldwide, making it the largest academic ranking of global universities.

Since **2016**, the Center for World University Rankings is headquartered in the United Arab Emirates.
