This research is aiming on shedding light on the psychological factors involued in kleptomania. Thought this phenomena exists in the society it has not been studid enough expecially in the arbic literature.

The sample consisted of 2 boys and 2 girls ranging from is to 18 years old. The four supjects were all secondry school students.

Presonal interview and assessment from (Mekheimer 1975), Scale of Partila instincts (31-Kattan, 1981), thematic Appreciation test have been performed on all cases.

The research deducted that a Narcisstic tendency, implsive compulsive acts some psychopathis tendescies and mood shifts are some of the psychological factos to have been among the causative issues of keleptomanie.
