INTRODUCTION AND AIM OF THE WORK

Mycoplasma pneumoniae is a major cause of respiratory infections in school-aged children (Denny, 1987).

Above the age of 4 years, pneumococcus and mycoplasma pneumoniae are the most frequently identified organisms and viruses are of lesser importance (Murphy et al., 1981).

Mycoplasma pneumoniae is endemic with epidemics every few years (Miragliotta & Fumarola, 1988).

Unfortunatelly there are no comprehensive reports about mycoplasma pneumoniae in childhood. So the aim of this study is to clarify the incidence of mycoplasma pneumoniae among the Egyptian children with acute respiratory infection.
