SUMMARY

No doubt that over population problem is one of the greatest problems all over the world. In this investigation we have studied the acceptability of different birth control methods in Dakahlia governorate which is considered the 2nd governorate according to it's population, it is located on either side of Damiatta branch of the nile, it consists of 10 cities and 433 villages.

On reviewing the different birth control methods we find that the most effective one is not the safest and the safest is not 100% effective.

On questionearing women in the family planning centres. We find that:

- (1) The pills is the most acceptable method because has nothing to do with sexual relations and it's efficacy is 100%.
- (2) The loop is the 2nd choce, because it cause vaginal bleeding, and its efficacy is not 100% as pill.
- (3) The condom comes after the pill and the loop, it's main advantages, are, hygienic, cheap and easy to use. However it interfere with sexual pleasure.

- (4) Dutch cap is not acceptable because it needs experienced women conserning its application more over it has a high failure rate.
- (5) We find considerable number of women prolong their laclation as a birth control method, also some women insert piece of sugar or piece of salt in the vagina before coitus.
- (6) Most women are still confused about sterilization women over 35 years especially which have five children or more accept any method of contraception, if pregnancy occur they go to abort themselves in the dark.
- (7) Birth control methods are used and more acceptable in urban than in rural areas, this difference is due to discripancy in educational status, mal-housing ... etc.

To solve this problem we must put the following points in the mind:

- (1) The problem indeed is a volumenous one.
- (2) Education will shorten the way.
- (3) We must start by rural areas.
- (4) Every method must be available especialy in rural areas.
- (5) Every couple must know every thing about contraception and its side effects, also know the complication

of repeated pregnancy and labour.

- (6) The religious acceptance should be clear and clean cut.
- (7) Medical survice must be at a higher level and should be provided by specialist.
- (8) The physician must choice the proper time to council a women about the method of contraception.
