Introduction:

The successive progress of civilization in all life aspects undoubtedly signifies the integration and unity of all social and institutional powers, and to achieve sport's excellence in the world champions and Olympics tournament, progressive countries do never hesitate in looking for new scientific means and innovations in addition to the participation of many scientist in the majority of specialization to achieve world sports initiation for sports excellence has become significant of intellectual civility of any community.

The researcher notices that Physical and sports Education has become one of the most important human and Social Sciences, at the beginning of the present century, and that it is not of no less importance than any other science. Football is one of the most popular games among the different social classes. Football is also the most important among the games that are planned for and programmed by modern scientific methods. Its training program must be executed upon accurate scientific basis, in collaboration with trainers and experts specialized in this field, each according to his specialization. Taking care of the athlete, through the preparation of specialized professional trainers, is one of the interesting and important matters. This preparation depends on applying the studied scientific

sports. It also aims at the necessity of emphasizing the role of sports trainers. Another aim of this research is supporting the current field with professional and specialized experiences which are qualified with scientific and practical knowledge of these challenges that have become clear. This is because the distinction in sports became an evidence of the communities' civilized, intellectual and scientific elevation, and because of the importance of competitive sports in the lives of the nations, and the need of the Republic of Yemen for such sport demonstrations. Which cause happiness and feelings of development inside any nation.

The Importance of the Research:

The research is important for achieving sport supremacy, to create new scientific means and to achieve the international sport event.

The Trainer job is not only to teach and train the player but also to educate and develop the moral and sport characteristics of the player. So, the trainer must have a special qualification according to the profession requirements.

The concentration on the Yemeni Football and the level of Yemen trainer ability is under the supervision of Yemeni Football Federation.

Research Mission:

The research aims at setting a suggested program to qualify the

- What are the requirements of the profession of Football training in Yemen?
- What is the content of the suggested training program to qualify Football trainers in Yemen?

Research Approach:-

The researcher used the descriptive approach for the scientific research because of the nature of this study. He also used the surveying approach for some of the international programs applied in the world according to the researcher's images and the research aims that depended on analyzing documents, explaining what exists and indicating events & Phenomena.

Research Field:

The research field is confined to competitive sport training of Football Teams in Yemen and this is through the trainers who practice the career of training Football.

The clubs that practice Football are (261) clubs, and are registered in the federation records. The approved clubs are (225) club and the remaining (36) clubs are on the way to be approved and the number of the registered players of Football are (2750) player.

Research Sample:

In collecting data according to the characteristics of the descriptive approach, the researcher has made use of the following tools: Applying the questionnaire of sports trainer, the proposed program for qualifying the Yemeni Football trainers according to profession requirements, analyzing the documents and references, explaining the results and statistics, using the arithmetic mean, percentage, the hypotheses, correlative coefficient, and using (×) to find function in the differences.

Research Results:

Throughout the research field, the selected subjects and the research results, the researcher includes the following results: -

- 1- There is a statistical significance for the requirements of the career of football training that has its effect both on the career level and on the level of developing & practicing the game, and this represents the ten axes that indicate the process of sports training with its vocational form in the research.
- 2-There is no executive training program to qualify football trainers in the Federation or in Yemen, and that most trainers who work in this field are not highly qualified but they had training course sponsored by the Federation via experts with the aid of the Arabian Football Federation or the Asian Football Federation, and that most trainers in the Federation records have practiced this sport as they want to

- 1-The Yemeni Football Federation should pay concern to trainers who work in the field, and to develop them inside and outside Yemen.
- 2-The application of the suggested training program to qualify the Yemen Football trainers to achieve the modern required level and to observe the sport development.
- 3-Creating a mechanism to observe the trainers and oblige them to attend the training courses that are held via the federation to establish stipulations to promote the trainers. The continuity of field work shows aspects of in the level of strength and deficiency football trainers in Yemen.
- 4- The annual evaluations of the national trainers who are registered in the Yemeni Football Federation and the determination of the requirement needed to promote the technical, administrative, and planning level.
- 5-Perfect planning to predict the future level of the football game, trainers and a perfect plan to achieve the desired aims in order to present a successful, and an efficient solutions.
- 6-Doing similar studies of all group and individual games in various Arabic societies.
