Summary

Hysterectomy is a commonly performed surgical procedure that impacts on many aspects of a woman's life. Removal of the uterus with or with out conservation of the ovaries is often threatens woman's femininity. Training programs for nurses about nursing intervention for women undergoing hysterectomy is a valid method for minimizing the negative physiological, emotional responses to the experience of surgery and at the same time, for promoting a rapid rate of recovery (*Andersen and Hacker*, 2001).

The aims of this study was to:

- 1- Assess nurse' knowledge and practice about caring of women Undergoing hysterectomy.
- 2- Design and implement training program about caring of women undergoing hysterectomy.
 - 3- Evaluate the effect of training program on nursing intervention.

*Setting:

The study was conducted at Gynecological Department of both Benha University and Teaching Hospital.

*sample: consisted of two parts;

1-Nurses:

Type: Convenient sample.

Size : All nurses work in operating room and gynecological ward in Obstetrics & Gynecological Department at Benha University Hospital (22), and also at Benha Teaching Hospital (18).

Characteristic of sample:

- All nurses work in operating room and gynecological room in Obstetrics & Gynecological Department at Benha University Hospital and also at Benha Teaching Hospital.
- With different qualification, age, and experience.

2-Patients:

Type: Simple random sample.

Size: Two group of patients were selected for the study :

Group 1: Number of (120 women) to assess nursing intervention before program application.

Group II: Number of (120) women to evaluate nursing intervention after program application.

Characteristics of sample:

- All patients who underlying hysterectomy operation .
- Patients with different educational level and different age groups Patients With different causes of hysterectomy.

Data collected using the following tools:

1- The structure-interviewing questionnaire:

which developed by the researcher under supervision of the supervisors of the study using different, updated review of literature. The questionnaire includes the following parts:

Part1:

1- socio-demographic data of nurses involved in the study such as (age, experience years, educational level, previous training, etc.).

2- Socio-demographic data of patients involved in the study such as (age, social class, marital status, obstetric and gynecological data, etc.).

Part 2:

Assessment of nurses' knowledge about caring of women undergoing hysterectomy (pre & post) tests include the following items:

- -Anatomy & physiology of female reproductive system.
- -Definition & types of hysterectomy.
- -Indications of hysterectomy.
- -Physical & psychosocial problems associated with hysterectomy.
- -Care of women (before, day, after) surgery. General discharge instructions.

II-Observational-checklist format:

It includes all procedures related to (pre, intra, post) operative care of hysterectomy, these will be used as a pre / post test.

A pilot study was carried out, according to its result, the necessary modification in the study tools and contents was done.

III-The training program:

According to the finding of pilot study, nurses needs were determined so, general & specific objectives of the program were stated, program content as well as teaching strategies was prepared. The training program for nurses about caring of women undergoing hysterectomy will consist of different sessions (theory & practice).

Theoretical sessions will include the following:

- Anatomy & physiology of female reproductive system.
- Definition & types of hysterectomy.

Summary

- Indications of hysterectomy.
- Physical & psychosocial problems associated with hysterectomy.
- Care of women (before, day, after) surgery.
- General discharge instructions.

Practical sessions will include all procedures related to the following:

- Preparation of patients before surgery (physical & psychological).
- Preparation of operating theatre.
- Post operative care (immediate & late) .

Evaluation:

The same tools used for the assessment (questionnaire sheet, Observational-checklist) were used to evaluate the effect of the program.

The study showed the following results:

- Lack of nurses' (knowledge & performance) regarding nursing care of women undergoing hysterectomy before the program implementation.
- Majority of nurses in both hospitals had average knowledge related to total knowledge with mean standard (60.4 ± 4.5) & (54.8 ± 13.0) before program implementation while after implementation of the program , it was found significant improvement with higher mean standard (78.1 ± 5.0) in university hospital & (77.0 ± 7.2) in teaching hospital .

- There was a significant improvement in nurses' performance about nursing intervention for hysterectomy patients post program implementation than pre implementation of the study.
- There was improvement in nurses performance level in teaching hospital (92.8%)than nurses in university hospital (89.1%)in relation to total performance level after program implementation.
- There was improvement in patients satisfaction about care provided to them after program implementation in both hospitals.
- There was a significant differences between pre &post program, also, between both hospitals in knowledge and practice.
