### **Abstract of the study**

#### • Introduction and problem of the study:

Based on the constant increase of the phenomenon of illegal youth in the Arab world in general and in Egypt in partricular has conducted the current study on the sociological analysis of the phenomenon of illegal immigration in its relations with rates of migration by the repercussions of globalization and youth attitudes towards liberalization and its impact in general on migrants, either in the country of origin or country Destination.

#### • Importance of the study:

The importance of the current study, in both sides, along with theoretical, and other Applied, The importance of the theory of the current study being seeking to try to address the sociological analysis of the phenomenon of illegal immigration in Egypt in terms of determinants and implications, and down to the forward looking vision on this phenomenon, whose practical importance in proposing ways to address them in the light of the results of the present study. #### • Objective of the study:

The present study aimed to investigate and analysis the heritage sociological phenomenon of migration in genral, and illegal immigration, particularly in light of the determinants of political, economic, social, and its repercussions among the countries of origin and destination, and through a field study on some young people from illegal immigration, and agents of migration legitimacy, and visions of intellectuals interested in some of the Egyptian society on the phenomenon of illegal immigration.

#### Approach, methods and tools of the study:

#### • The study sample:

#### • Results of the study:
