## INTRODUCTION

Ultrasonography is a safe, quick and non-invasive procedure that proved to be an essential part of modern gynaecologic and obstetric practice. In obstetrics, ultrasonography provides a detailed and a high resolution image of the gravid uterus. Placentography implies a pricise description of the placenta in the uterus. Its texture, volume and site of implantation could be detected ultrasonically. The sonographic evaluation of patients with suspected trophoblastic disease has proven to be quite accurate and specific in patients with hydatidiform mole.
