INTRODUCTION

Ectropion:

Is a condition in which the margin of the lid is turned outward.

This may vary in degree from slight eversion at the punctum to complete turning out of the lid margin with exposure of the conjunctiva.

it is a common condition particularly in old age (senile ectropion).

Ectrepien has received the attention of physicians through the ages and it never ceases to be a topic of discussion among ephthalmologists to day as evidenced by the numerous papers appearing in the Interature.
