In this study the researcher conducts

"A study of the relationship between Assertiveness and aggressiveness on university ____ students.

The aim of the study :-

This study aims to study the relationship between assertiveness and ubnormal, normal aggressiveness on undergraduate students.

The study Hypotheses:-

- 1- There is a negative statistical correlation between assertiveness and ubnormal aggressiveness in the male undergraduate students .
- 2- There is a negative statistical corrolation between assertiveness and ubnormal aggressiveness in the female undergraduates .
- 3- There is a positive statistical correlation between assertiveness and normal aggressiveness in the male undergraduate students .

- 4- There is a positive statistical correlation between assertiveness and normal aggressiveness in the female undergraduate students .
- 5- There are significant statistical differences between non-assertiveness (males& fem les) and assertiveness (males& femolés) in level of ubnormal aggressiveness on favour of non assertiveness.
- 6- There are significant statistical differences between assertiveness (males& females) and non assertiveness (males& females) in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness.
- 7- There are significant statistical differences between assertiveness (males) and assertiveness (females) in the level of the ubnormal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males).
- 8- There are sigificant statistical d fferences between assertiveness (males) and assertiveness (females) in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males).

- 9 There are significant statistical differences between non assertiveness (males) and non assertiveness (famales) in the level of ubnormal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males).
- 10- There are significant statistical differences between non assertiveness (males) and non assertiveness (famales) in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males).

The sample consists of 200 assertivenes and non - assertiveness undergraduates of the 3rd & 4th years of different departments from the Faculty Of Education in Benha - Egypt chosen at random. Half of the sample is male and the other one is female . Aged between 19 - 22 years , the mean is $20\ \frac{1}{2}$.

The sample was divided into four groups as follows

3rd .G - 50 .Non - assertiveness males.
