

ABSTRACT OF THE THESIS

In this study the researcher conducts
" A study of the relationship between Assertiveness
and aggressiveness on university students .

The aim of the study :-

This study aims to study the relationship between
assertiveness and abnormal, normal aggressiveness on
undergraduate students .

The study Hypotheses :-

- 1- There is a negative statistical correlation between
assertiveness and abnormal aggressiveness in the male
undergraduate students .
- 2- There is a negative statistical correlation between
assertiveness and abnormal aggressiveness in the
female undergraduates .
- 3- There is a positive statistical correlation between
assertiveness and normal aggressiveness in the male
undergraduate students .

- 4- There is a positive statistical correlation between assertiveness and normal aggressiveness in the female undergraduate students .
- 5- There are significant statistical differences between non-assertiveness (males & females) and assertiveness (males & females) in level of abnormal aggressiveness on favour of non - assertiveness .
- 6- There are significant statistical differences between assertiveness (males & females) and non - assertiveness (males & females) in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness .
- 7- There are significant statistical differences between assertiveness (males) and assertiveness (females) in the level of the abnormal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males) .
- 8- There are significant statistical differences between assertiveness (males) and assertiveness (females) in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males) .

- 9 - There are significant statistical differences between non - assertiveness (males) and non - assertiveness (females) in the level of abnormal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males).
- 10- There are significant statistical differences between non - assertiveness (males) and non - assertiveness (females) in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (males) .

The sample :-

The sample consists of 200 assertiveness and non - assertiveness undergraduates of the 3rd & 4th years of different departments from the Faculty Of Education in Benha - Egypt chosen at random. Half of the sample is male and the other one is female . Aged between 19 - 22 years , the mean is $20 \frac{1}{2}$.

The sample was divided into four groups as follows

The results of the study :

1- There is a negative statistical correlation between assertiveness and unnormal aggressiveness in both male and female undergraduates .

2- There is a positive statistical correlation between assertiveness and normal aggressiveness in both male and female undergraduates .

3- There are significant statistical difference between non - assertiveness (males & females) and assertiveness (males & females) in the level of unnormal aggressiveness .

- 4- There are significant statistical difference between assertiveness (male■& female■)and non - assertiveness (male■& female■)in the level of normal aggressiveness on favour of assertiveness (male■& female■) .
- 5- There are not significant statistical difference between assertiveness (male■) and assertiveness (female)in the level of ubnormal aggressiveness .
- 6- There are not significant statistical difference between assertiveness (male■) and assertiveness (female■)in the level of normal aggressiveness .
- 7- There are not significant statistical difference between non - assertiveness (male■)and non - assertiveness (female■) in the level of ubnormal aggressiveness .
