

Introduction:

Family plays important roles to its members, especially its childrens. The more the socity has strong relation among its members in general or between famliy members in particular, the more strong and progressive the society will be. It is of course true since the lack of closeness in such relations will in contrast lead to the dissociation of this society. Scientific progress have many increasing and inflaming negative effects on family members, such as voilence, crimes, family conflicts and delinquency. For example delinquency is one of the dangours psychological and social diseases because the delinquent becomes a problematic child for society to the degree that he threatens elements and main sources of welfare in society, therefore a lot of researchers have studied personality traits of delinquents and the factors which have led to delinquency.
