

INTRODUCTION

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Testicular neoplasms are rare tumours which are seen in all ages but predominate in men between the ages of 20 to 35 years. Neoplasms of the testes itself are almost universally malignant.

Malignant neoplasms of the testes may be of germinal or nongerminal origin. The later tumours are relatively rare producing quantities of androgenizing hormones which may cause precocious puberty in young males.

Recently there is a great advances in all branches of medicine especially the early diagnosis of cancer by the use of tumour markers and serological testes, ultrasonography, CT scanning with promising results in its treatment.

The aim of this work, is to throw ligh on this subject, and to review the evaluation of the various methods of the early diagnosis of testicular tumours and different lines of treatment.
