Laparoscopic bilateral uterine artery ligation is a promising new method of treating refractory menorrhagia. It may be offered as an alternative to hysterectomy in selected women who wish to preserve their uterus. In cases of dysfunctional menorrhagia, reduction of menstrual blood loss (MBL) is not associated with marked reduction of uterine volume.
